In the Bar, host **Robin Ince** (XFM & Channel 5) mingles with the audience invading their privacy. An installation by **Irrational Response** (Marc Garrett, Steve Rushton, Kate Pointon, Peter Lamb) explores transgression, dysfunction and alienation. Plus surreal sketches from MTV's **Baron Brothers**, a stunning new installation by performance artist **Picono Vilalta**, a peepshow booth, and music by Sonic DJ **Slang** (NME) and **DJ Ravi**.

Film shorts *The East London Institute of Needlecraft* (Jes Benstock) and *Peepshow* (Joe Taylor) are in the Theatre, whilst your reaction to a live erotic performance is broadcast in the Bar. Absurdist comedians **The Pod** present their multimedia set *Cloth Dreams*.
